## Don't you enjoy a clean beach strand?

Our town crews work very hard at keeping our beach strand clean and free of trash. The schedule for strand pick up is as follows:

- \*Monday
- \*Wednesday
- \*Friday
- \*Saturday
- \*Sunday



(7 days per week as required.)

\*As always, if you spot trash or debris that needs to be disposed of, you can help out too. There are many trash barrels along our strand and streets, or just call Wrightsville Beach Public Works to have it picked up.

### Helpful Hints:

- Items other than regular cart trash such as yard debris, appliances, and furniture are collected at an additional charge and by request only.
- Personal items that are left on the strand such as tents, umbrellas, and chairs are left at your own risk as the Town can not be held responsible for these items.
- If you bring trash to the beach, please dispose of it properly, or take it home with you.

## What to do with that "Doggie-Doo"

You are required to pick up after your pet, and dispose of it in available trash cans, as defined by town ordinances 91.02 and 91.08. (Waste on the sidewalks and grass increases pollution in our surrounding waters, which you can find the results of in our posted swim advisories, and encourages rodent infestation.)

*There are a few other things to remember when having fun with our "four-legged" friends...*

- Pets must be on a leash at all times when visiting our strand. It's the law.
- All pets are restricted from the beach strand between April 1 – Sept. 30.

Our ordinances are to ensure the residents and visitors will enjoy our community.

There are also water stations for our "four-legged" friends, so remember to keep them hydrated. (Pets can have heat strokes, too.)
